Under served and Low resource settings



What ICS SP is doing




Fanikisha Uajibikaji Nyanjani (FUN)

- Normative behaviour change intervention implemented in Kisumu, Kenya and Shinyanga, Tanzania
- High prevalence of VAC&W incidents including child marriage, teen pregnancy, intimate partner violence
- Violations are rooted in social and gender norms that perpetuate gender inequalities at household and community levels
- FUN intervention works with grassroot community members as change agents to co-create and co-design a normative behavior change intervention to prevent Violence against Children and Women (VAC&W)
